Academics:

We at Saini International School, Howrah have been proactive in embracing the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, ensuring that our educational practices align with its vision of holistic, inclusive, and learner-centred education. Adhering to the new structure of 5+3+3+4 of school education, we have incorporated Play-Way method of learning in the Foundational Stage at the same time developing their foundational literacy, numeracy and cognitive skills

At this stage we are not only focusing on the physical, motor and cognitive development of a child but also on their Socio – emotional, ethical as well as cultural development. Our young learners took the spotlight as they independently explored a range of hands –on activities! From practical life exercises to sensory-based activities, our students showcased independence, creativity, and an enthusiastic love for learning. Parents proudly observed their children grow through experiential learning and self-discovery—key principles of learning. These activities highlighted the beauty of allowing children to learn at their own pace in a nurturing environment that supports both their minds and hearts.

One of the innovative ideas that NEP 2020 proposes, is the **Bagless Day** where students get the opportunity to learn Beyond Books. We brought this innovative idea into practice where our Class I to VIII students were thrilled when they had a few fun-filled Bagless days which allows them to learn new skills.

We celebrated the **Science Exploration** week. The Middle as well as Senior wing students showcased their ingenuity and scientific prowess. Students participated in poster making and visual presentations. The celebration ended with many awe-inspiring model presentations. The young minds explored a multitude of topics, from the intricacies of a hydraulic lift to harnessing renewable energy with windmills, solar panels and many more. And the year was full of many more interesting activities, cultural events, competitions etc.

Academic Excellence:

Achieving academic excellence is at the heart of endeavour of all educators and academic institutions. An important measure of this pursuit is how the institution has performed, the most important of which is the Annual, School-ending examinations conducted by the CBSE.

We are proud to acknowledge that we had good result, achievement in academics, Co-curricular and extracurricular activities throughout the session. BOARD EXAMINATION

Our students have once again set high academic benchmarks by excelling in the Board Examinations of 2025- 2026. Their outstanding performance reflects the hard work of both students and teachers, making us immensely proud. Our students and teachers have worked tirelessly to uphold the school's vision of fostering holistic development. We take pride in announcing almost 100% results of CBSE class X & XII board examination 2026. Our students once again excelled in academics, securing outstanding results, with over **40% students achieving above 90%**. The highest being **99.4 secured by two students in Class X Board Exam and 96.4 in class XII Board Exam.**

Our students participate regularly in Science, Social Science, Computer, General Knowledge, Mathematics and English Olympiad Examinations and receive Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals and Certificates. Our students have outshined in the IOS SILVER ZONE OLYMPIAD, SPELLATHEON, TALENT SEARCH, SOF OLYMPIAD, GREEN OLYMPIAD (THE ENERGY & RESOURCE INSTITUTE, NATIONAL AUTOMOBILE OLYMPIAD etc.

We have successfully conducted CBSE SAFAL ASSESSMENT for the classes VI & IX, ensuring a smooth and efficient process to evaluate students learning outcomes. Our school's Annual Sports Day **"Anantam Potentia"** was a mesmerizing spectacle of Drill, Karate and outstanding sports performances

Orientation Programmes:

- Students from different classes of SIS Howrah showed their excellence **and won medal of excellence in STEM Olympiad**. Torsha Chandra, Subhrajyoti Hait, Sunay Ghosh, Rudropriyo Bose, Atiya Zinnat Khan, Ipsit Patra and Gohona Das Mahapatra won the Gold class toppers category. The Silver Class topper were bagged by Ayansh Sk, Saumit Ghosh, Jyoti Ranjan Bera and Shreyan Hait. The Bronze Class toppers were Bihan Islam Veer & Barshneyee Mitra.
- Students from different classes of SIS Howrah showed their excellence in International Talent Hunt Olympiad (ITHO) and won a medal of excellence. Alayna Tahfeem, Torsa Chandra, Anirva Pradhan, Samya Bera, Ankit Samanta, Aurna Siddhanta, Atiya Zinnat Khan, Sanav Khan and Anirban Panja won the **Gold class toppers category**. The Silver Class

toppers were bagged by Subhrojyoti Hait, Stabopriya Kolay, Soujanya Majhi, Debadrita Dutta, Aditi Debnath, and Gohona Das Mahapatra. **The Bronze Class topper** is Ananya Chowdhury.

- In the **Silverzone IRO Olymiad**, Alayna Tahfeen (Std 2A), Torsha Chandra (Std 3B), Sunay Ghosh (Std 6B), Aurna Siddhanta (Std 7C), Atiya Zinnat Khan (Std8B) and Ipsit Patra (Std 9B) have received **the Gold medal of excellence**. Ankit Samanta (Std 6A), Ahana Ghara (Std 7A), Debadrita Dutta (Std 8C) and Ananya Choudhary (Std 9A) won **Silver medal**. The **Bronze Medal** of excellence was won by Sourish Sarkar (Std 8B).
- VVM, a national program aimed at popularizing science among students from standard 6 to 11, supported by Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA, the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) and National Council of Science Museums (NCSM) set their second state camp at Saini International School Maheshtala Kolkata on 11th January, 2026. **Manjarit Banerjee (XI Science) and Syed Jihan (X)** from Saini International school, Howrah qualified to the WB State level (Level III) from Howrah district and performed significantly good to the 2nd state camp (West Bengal South region) conducted at Saini International Maheshtala.

Sports and Co-curricular Activities:

- Ahana Chakraborty participated in the Sports-a-thlon 2025-26 organized by Delhi Public School, Howrah, Competing in the Under-10 Girls category. Ahana showcased her exceptional swimming skills and secured the 1st position (Gold Medal) in both the 50-metre Freestyle and 25-metre Freestyle events.

- Students participated at the International Karate Championship held in Lumbini, Nepal. With a total of 5 participants, the team achieved outstanding results: Sneha Hui of Std 6 have bagged Gold Medal in Kata and Bronze Medal in Kumite, Rajdeep Bag of Std 5 got Gold Medal in both Kata and Kumite, Sunay Ghosh of Std 6 has received Silver Medal in both Kata and Kumite. Lastly, we have Shreyan Hait of Std 8 who has bagged Silver Medal in Kata and Bronze Medal in Kumite Congratulations to all for their outstanding achievements.
- Few teachers from SIS Howrah participated in an event on the occasion of Teacher's Day at Indian Institute of Hotel Management and Catering Technology (IIHM) and also received award with their dexterous skill and performance.

- On 3rd September, 2025, some students from SIS Howrah went for the Young metro force meet at Birla High School Mukundapur, and were awarded certificates of excellence for their contribution to The Telegraph Young Metro Force 2023-24.
- Students from SIS Howrah participated in Logiquids Mental Aptitude Olympiad 2024-25 and showed their outstanding performance by securing Trophy and certificates.
- Students from SIS Howrah performed and secured their positions in the event of Abacus Prodigy Competition 2025.
- Our students participated in Utsav, an Inter-School Competition organized by P. B. Academic School. 34 students took part in eight categories, our students won three prizes — first in Dance and Photography, and third in Basketball.
